

After a rigorous three-month selection process that began with more than 700 applicants, we are proud to announce that 65 students from Tacoma, Seattle, Portland, Spokane and the Yakima Valley have been named 2013 Act Six scholars at eight Northwest colleges. Collectively, their scholarships are worth more than \$8 million over four years. Benson's own Michael Ely was honored as one of these winners!
