LSAC aims to increase leadership and civic engagement among youth residing in the Portland Metro area. We are currently accepting applications and how that you'll apply!

Latino Student Action Committee participants will have the opportunity to:

- ❖ Improve the state of their community by leading a service project
- Learn and practice important leadership skills
- ❖ Work with other young leaders hungry to make an impact in their community
- ❖ Form relationships with Latino leaders while learning what local organizations are doing to improve the communities throughout the Portland Metro area

Latino Student Action Committee members will be required to participate in the following:

- Orientation
- Cohort retreat
- Two workshops per month (Approx.15 sessions)
- Team building activities
- Service Learning Project
- Closing Ceremony and Project Presentation

EVERYONE is welcome to apply! We welcome all students! However, you must be in high school and between the ages of 14-18. Meetings will take place twice a month from October to June. They will tentatively be held on Saturdays and Thursdays (after school) at various locations throughout the Portland Metro area.

The application deadline is **Monday, October 23, 2017 by 5:00pm.**

The first LSAC meeting will take place <u>Saturday</u>, <u>November 11, 2017 at 10:00am</u>. This program is free to all participants. Transportation costs will be subsidized as needed. Latino Network will also provide a meal and snacks at every meeting.
