

GIS Online Story Mapping for High School Girls



Join us at this one-day workshop to learn how to create an online story map of a multi-modal transportation system.

Held in the Intelligent Transportation Systems lab at Portland State University (PSU), students will be introduced to ArcGIS and will have the opportunity to explore and create maps using already available data. By the end of the day, you will be able to tell a compelling story about transportation systems and its connection to the surrounding community and neighborhood. You'll also gain a technical vocabulary in talking about transportation.

The day-long workshop includes a mix of classroom lessons, applied activities, and a walking tour of active transportation infrastructure around the PSU campus!
