### **How to Stay Informed**

The website has information about personal learning requirements, apprenticeship connection, as well as, job opportunities.

### **Personal Learning Requirements:**

All students need to complete two Career Related Learning Experiences (CRLE). These are completed when students participate in a career exposure event and reflect on that experience. If your student needs to complete one, the links are available below:

**Requirement 1:** CRLE Link #1 (Google Form)

**Requirement 2:** CRLE # 2 (Google Form)

**Requirement 3: Resume-**

Students are also required to complete and submit a resume. This is usually completed in US History and submitted to the Google Classroom. There are several workshops throughout the year that help student prepare a resume and ace an interview.

### **Requirement 4: My Plan Response (Seniors Only)-**

There are three questions that students will answer on a word or google document. Once finished, upload to the 2019 Google Classroom:

- 1. Explain your career aspirations and your educational plan to meet these goals. Clearly articulate both short and long term goals and describe the interests, skills, and experiences that helped you develop your post-high school plan.
- 2. Explain how you have helped your family or made your community a better place to live. Provide specific examples and include what you learned from these experiences. How did these experiences help to inform your post-high school plan?



3. Describe a personal accomplishment and the strengths and skills you used to achieve it. Consider your growth during your four years in high school. How will this experience serve you in your future?
