This one-week residence camp offers any student entering the 9–12 grade an immersive introduction to the workings of the Portland transportation system. Half of each day is spent in the classroom hearing from PSU faculty and guest lecturers from ODOT, the FHWA, the Portland Bureau of Transportation, TriMet, the Port of Portland, and various other public and private transportation agencies that operate



in the Portland metro area. The other half is spent outside, in field tours of Portland's transportation infrastructure and public spaces.
