Summer STEM Camps focusing on Transportation will be held at Oregon Tech in Klamath Falls, and two at Portland State (PSU). **There is no cost to attend.** Applications are due April 1st, and students must have at least a 2.0 GPA and a letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor. Each STEM-based camp will educate the students about careers in transportation such as engineering and planning, many students are unaware of the opportunities that exist within the transportation field. Students will be fully immersed in the college experience living in residence halls, eating in campus dining halls, attending lectures with college faculty, and working hands-on in state of the art labs and classrooms. They will learn how to conduct research, learn college prep and study skills, build self-awareness, learn healthy life skills, gain exposure to community-based organizations, explore philanthropic endeavors and more.

Mostly, these camps are FUN! Students at the OIT camp will go on bike rides, visit Crater Lake National Park and travel to WaterWorks Park in Redding, California Students that attend the PSU camps can expect bike tours, scavenger hunts, jet boat rides and field trips to Multnomah Falls, OMSI and other sites.

What a week it was for Benson Tech athletics.

If winning the 2018-19 6A OSAA Women's Basketball State Tournament in spectacular fashion wasn't enough, we had two other masterful athletic accomplishments this week to remind folks just how many talented students, and student-athletes we have here at Benson Tech.

Welcome Back, Benson VARSITY Softball:

Benson Softball last played a varsity softball game on May 2, 2017. The program was touchand-go for a while before Benson Tech teacher Linda McLellan stepped-up to lead the Benson Softball program through a **JV schedule** during the **2018 season.**

Fast-forward a year, and new (and former) Head Coach Katie Meyer has assumed control of the program with Coach McLellan serving in an assistant coach role for the 2019 season.

On Thursday, Benson Softball not only played its first varsity softball game since May 2, 2017, the Techsters got off to a quick start vs. Beaverton High School, scoring 5 runs before Beaverton recorded its first out.

The Techsters went on to win 13-3 in 5 innings, 10-run "ruling" the Beavers. This resulted in Benson Softball's first varsity win since March 27, 2017. What a fantastic beginning to a renewed and revived Benson Softball program.

Micah Williams wins NATIONAL Indoor Track Title:

Junior sprinter Micah Williams exploits are well known. As a sophomore, Williams won the 100m and 200m OSAA 6A sprint championships. He then mad the US Junior Olympic Team and anchored the Gold Medal winning 4x100 team for Team USA.

On Sunday, Williams added to his impressive resume by winning the 60m Indoor NATIONAL Title running a 6.60 60m final.

Williams 6.60 time is good for THIRD. ALL. TIME. Amongst high school sprinters. He was named Track Athlete of the Event.

Williams and the Benson Boys' and Girls' Track teams will begin spring competition on Wednesday, March 20 in a dual meet at Grant High School.
