[The Construct Foundation](#) is partnering with the [Portland Innovation Quadrant](#) to run our 5th annual two-week immersive design challenge this summer for high-school-aged students. really cool (FREE!) opportunity and we're hoping you might help us to recruit students to the program. The design challenge is a two-week commitment at the end of June (6/17-6/28), and this year the topic will be around health and wellness in vulnerable communities. In the two weeks, we teach students the design thinking process, guide them through the design process in the problem space, support them as they design a solution concept that could feasibly live in the real world, and coach them as they create a pitch of their idea.
