## HOW TO STAY INFORMED

To get the most current career opportunities, text @CCINFO to 81010. You will receive a text message any time there is a job opening, or new career opportunity. The other way to get the most current information is to check out the Career Website: <https://goo.gl/VSSnpW>. The website has information about personal learning requirements, apprenticeship connection, as well as, job opportunities.

## PERSONAL LEARNING REQUIREMENT

All students need to complete two Career Related Learning Experiences (CRLE). These are completed when students participate in a career exposure event and reflect on that experience. If your student needs to complete one, the links are available below:
