College Applications:

- For information on completing college applications, please refer to our <u>College Website</u> and the <u>Applying to College</u>.
- If you need school documentation sent to colleges, like transcripts or letters of recommendation, you must request documentation through Maia Learning, our college and career platform.
- If applying to colleges that require the Common App, you must link the Common App to Maia Learning. See <u>Applying to College</u> information.

Financial Aid:

- · If you will be applying to colleges (4-year colleges or community colleges), complete the <u>FAFSA</u> financial aid application or <u>ORSAA</u> (non-US citizen students) so that you can receive financial aid if you qualify.
- If you have completed a FAFSA, be sure <u>all</u> your schools are listed. You will not receive financial aid from a school that is not listed on your FAFSA.
- · Please find a list of scholarships on the Benson College Website on the Scholarship tab.
- If you are applying to community college and have at least a 2.5 GPA, you may qualify for the Oregon Promise which will provide a scholarship that pays up to all of your tuition at any Oregon community college. See application for the Oregon Promise.
- The <u>OSAC</u> scholarship application is open. OSAC is one application that links Oregon students to hundreds of scholarships.
- The <u>Ford Family Foundation Scholarship</u> is for students who have significant financial need. It covers 90% of Tuition AND Room/Board.

A Message from the BHS Attendance Office

We encourage students to attend on a regular basis. Studies show that missing more than one day per month can actually lead to poorer grades and contributes to dropping out of school.

Naturally, we understand that there are occasions that a student must miss a school day. When this happens it is important for you to contact the school to let us know the reason for the absence. Please remember to communicate directly with the attendance office if your student will be absent for any period of time during the school day. The best ways to let us know are, in order of school preference:

Send an email to the attendance office at benson-attendance@pps.net
Call the attendance line directly at 503-916-5109
Call the school main office number at 503-916-5100 - Select option 3
Send a note via your student excusing the absence

Always remember, we need the STUDENT NAME, ID# (if known) and REASON FOR THE ABSENCE. (Saying it is an excused absence does not give us the reason, please be specific) The Attendance Office will check messages and emails at 7:30am and throughout the school day. The attendance phone line is continuously busy throughout the school day. An email provides a written message directly to the attendance office. The attendance office can excuse previous absences up to three days after the absence occurs. After the three days, corrections cannot be made.

You can monitor your child's attendance through ParentVUE. Contact the school if you do not know how to access ParentVUE.

A Message from the BHS Attendance Office

If you do not communicate with the school, we cannot properly record your child's absence. If you have any questions regarding your child's attendance do not hesitate to email or call the attendance office. Please help us, help your student have a successful year here at Benson Tech.

With the advent of distance learning, there are some questions that have arisen. I am finding that the majority of questions regarding attendance are addressing asynchronous classes. The following is an explanation of how this and other attendance calls could be avoided.

Asynchronous days are not live sessions with the instructor. There are various ways your student can contact the teacher for attendance purposes.

They log on and just check in with the teacher.

They contact the teacher by emailing if they have any questions or need assistance with the assignment.

They complete the posted assignment and turn it in. The assignment cannot be turned in late to count toward attendance. While they may receive credit for turning it in late they would still be counted as absent if they don't contact the teacher in another way.

Their parent may email the attendance email at benson-attendance@pps.net to leave a valid reason for the absence (illness, appointment, etc.)

If you get a call saying your student has missed a period, I would correspond with the classroom teacher directly. I will always need authorization from the classroom teacher to correct an absence. By contacting the teacher directly, they can send me an email for a quick correction. This is also important because the State of Oregon mandates that I may not make corrections to attendance more than three school days prior to the current school date.
