A 5-week virtual course geared toward individuals age 17-26 with a vested interest in pursuing a manufacturing career. Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship participants will gain relevant industry-specific technical knowledge and employability skills, obtain welding and work-safety experience, earn a Certified Manufacturing Associate Certificate, and learn about apprenticeships, trades, Portland companies, and post-secondary tracks. Successful graduates will have an opportunity for a paid internship or direct employment with a local manufacturing company.
