PORTLAND STATE UNIVERSITY:

The PSU application is still open. It is **free to apply** through June 15th. PSU has also lowered its GPA requirement for admission to 2.5. PSU also has a program which offers 4 years of free tuition for those who qualify. See PSU website for more information.

PCC:

FINANCIAL AID:

If applying to colleges (4-year or community colleges), complete the <u>FAFSA</u> financial aid application or <u>ORSAA</u> (non-US citizen students) so that you can receive financial aid if you qualify. Be sure <u>all</u> your schools are listed. You won't receive financial aid from a school that is not listed on your FAFSA/ORSAA.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

March 12 <u>Greenfield Peace Scholarship</u> (This year's scholarship is for students who identify as BIPOC - Black, Indigenous, People of Color)

March 31 <u>Hearthstone Housing Scholarship</u> (Must live in Multnomah Co. and be from a low-income household)

April 1 PCC Future Connect (Scholarship money and mentorship program for first generation in family to attend college or low-income)

May 7 Albina Rotary/Neil Kelly Scholarship (For students living in designated areas of North & Northeast Portland)

June 1 Oregon Promise (Free tuition at any Oregon Community College. Must have a 2.5 GPA)
