## Student Schedule For This Week

To continue student progress, students are completing coursework in all classes asynchronously. Each day, students should log into Canvas/Classrooms and complete the assigned work. Teachers will be posting assignments connected to course content, and/or curated modules focusing on careers, racial equity and social justice, resume-building, digital citizenship, financial literacy, and other topics/themes related to their course or grade level.

## Hybrid Cohort Information

All students have been assigned to their Hybrid/CDL cohort based on survey responses. You can see your cohort assignment in ParentVue/StudentVue by looking under the student info tab. Students that indicated they would like to remain in CDL are also tagged as such. You should have received an email indicating your cohort assignment and the corresponding schedule for hybrid instruction.

***All morning live virtual (synchronous) classes remain the same for all classes.***

There have been adjustments to the start and end time for classes to accommodate for lunch time travel. ***See the new bell schedule that begins on April 19th [here](#) or on our website.***

**Cohort A** will attend in person classes on the Monday and Tuesday afternoons and do async work on Thursday and Friday afternoons.

**Cohort B** will attend in person classes on Thursday and Friday afternoons and do async work on Monday and Tuesday afternoons.

**The CDL cohort** will remain virtual and async in the afternoon all week.

**Wednesday will remain asynchronous** class time and virtual teacher office hours for all. Please look for upcoming information regarding the safe return to school.

### **WHAT TO EXPECT:**

- You will have to wear a mask (that covers your nose and mouth) the entire time you are in Benson.
- You will have to stay 6 feet away from others at all times.
- Once you are in the classroom, you will not be able to leave as freely as you used to.
- In person classes will **ONLY** be in the afternoon, from 1:05 to 3:45, and **ONLY** 2x/week.
- No new or direct instruction will be delivered during in-person instruction.
- You will be expected to engage in CDL in the mornings.

## FREE CREDIT RECOVERY PROGRAM AT BENSON TECH

Hello Benson Tech Students,

I am sure many of you know who I am, but in case you don't my name is Daniel Garcia. I am the Instructional Facilitator and Freshmen Success Team Lead at Benson Tech. Starting on Tuesday February 16th, we will begin a program allowing those students who need to make up previous credits for courses they did not successfully complete. This program is free and is available to all students and grades. Our credit retrieval program process is rather easy. After signing a completion agreement, students will begin working on their course(s) online in CANVAS. A mentor will be assigned to you to support your needs, as well as, any questions you may have as you work through your course material. Once you complete your course(s), a teacher within that subject area will grade the work and determine your final grade. Lastly, a grade change form will be sent to your counselor and your grade will be changed. If you have more than one course to retrieve the credit for, you will continue working until all of your credit retrieval courses are complete. The teachers, administrators, and support staff at Benson want nothing more than for you to succeed and graduate. We will do all we can to support you and your educational and career goals. **Please contact me so we can get you back on track. I'll be waiting to hear from you.**

## **A Message from the BHS Attendance Office**

We encourage students to attend on a regular basis. Studies show that missing more than one day per month can actually lead to poorer grades and contributes to dropping out of school.

Naturally, we understand that there are occasions that a student must miss a school day. When this happens it is important for you to contact the school to let us know the reason for the absence. Please remember to communicate directly with the attendance office if your student will be absent for any period of time during the school day. The best ways to let us know are, in order of school preference:

Send an email to the attendance office at [benson-attendance@pps.net](mailto:benson-attendance@pps.net)

Call the attendance line directly at 503-916-5109

Call the school main office number at 503-916-5100 - Select option 3

Send a note via your student excusing the absence

Always remember, we need the STUDENT NAME, ID# (if known) and REASON FOR THE ABSENCE. (Saying it is an excused absence does not give us the reason, please be specific) The Attendance Office will check messages and emails at 7:30am and throughout the school day.. The attendance phone line is continuously busy throughout the school day. An email provides a written message directly to the attendance office. The attendance office can excuse previous absences up to three days after the absence occurs. After the three days, corrections cannot be made.

You can monitor your child's attendance through ParentVUE. Contact the school if you do not know how to access ParentVUE.

## **A Message from the BHS Attendance Office**

If you do not communicate with the school, we cannot properly record your child's absence. If you have any questions regarding your child's attendance do not hesitate to email or call the attendance office. Please help us, help your student have a successful year here at Benson Tech.

With the advent of distance learning, there are some questions that have arisen. I am finding that the majority of questions regarding attendance are addressing asynchronous classes. The following is an explanation of how this and other attendance calls could be avoided.

Asynchronous days are not live sessions with the instructor. There are various ways your student can contact the teacher for attendance purposes.

They log on and just check in with the teacher.

They contact the teacher by emailing if they have any questions or need assistance with the assignment.

They complete the posted assignment and turn it in. The assignment cannot be turned in late to count toward attendance. While they may receive credit for turning it in late they would still be counted as absent if they don't contact the teacher in another way.

Their parent may email the attendance email at [benson-attendance@pps.net](mailto:benson-attendance@pps.net) to leave a valid reason for the absence (illness, appointment, etc.)

If you get a call saying your student has missed a period, I would correspond with the classroom teacher directly. I will always need authorization from the classroom teacher to correct an absence. By contacting the teacher directly, they can send me an email for a quick correction. This is also important because the State of Oregon mandates that I may not make corrections to attendance more than three school days prior to the current school date.
