### **Modernization Updates:**

The new CTE Annex building that will house Manufacturing, Automotive and Tech Geometry is underway on the Marshall campus. They've broken ground on the Marshall Campus and the prefab pieces that will make up the building are already onsite. Once the concrete is poured for the floor, the rest would go up fairly quickly. The move on campus is ramping up as pieces of equipment that will not follow programs to the Marshall campus are being disconnected and in many cases auctioned on the <a href="auction.gov">auction.gov</a> site. Much of the classroom equipment currently on our campus will be used to fill the old Kenton school in North Portland which will serve as the home to the Multiple Pathways to Graduation Program for the next three years. When they return, they will have a building of their own in what is now the teacher's parking lot near Buckman Field.

#### FREE CREDIT RECOVERY PROGRAM AT BENSON TECH

Hello Benson Tech Students,

I am sure many of you know who I am, but in case you don't my name is Daniel Garcia. I am the Instructional Facilitator and Freshmen Success Team Lead at Benson Tech. Starting on Tuesday February 16th, we will begin a program allowing those students who need to make up previous credits for courses they did not successfully complete. This program is free and is available to all students and grades. Our credit retrieval program process is rather easy. After signing a completion agreement, students will begin working on their course(s) online in CANVAS. A mentor will be assigned to you to support your needs, as well as, any questions you may have as you work through your course material. Once you complete your course(s), a teacher within that subject area will grade the work and determine your final grade. Lastly, a grade change form will be sent to your counselor and your grade will be changed. If you have more than one course to retrieve the credit for, you will continue working until all of your credit retrieval courses are complete. The teachers, administrators, and support staff at Benson want nothing more than for you to succeed and graduate. We will do all we can to support you and your educational and career goals. Please contact me so we can get you back on track. I'll be waiting to hear from you.
