#### A Message From Jessica Murchison/Benson's Testing Coordinator

This is a reminder that **PSAT testing is Wednesday, October 13th**.

<u>All sophomores</u> and <u>juniors that signed up</u> need to check in *by 8:15am*. Students will check-in at the main entrance in the front of the building by the office.

Once timed testing has begun, students will not be allowed to enter the test.

Students will not be allowed to have backpacks, bags, cell phones, smartwatches, electronics, food, or drink (including water) in the testing room.

Please leave these items at home if possible.

These items will be collected at school if they are brought with students.

There will be a bag check in the auditorium and cell phones or smartwatches will be collected by the proctor before testing can begin. Any students that still have their cell phones or smartwatches at any time during the test, including breaks, will be asked to leave the testing room and their test will be invalidated.

There will be breakfast and lunch available for students in the cafeteria. Breakfast from 8-8:30am and from 12-1 after the test for students to grab and go.

Students should bring with them a calculator and 2 #2 pencils. Calculator must not be wired or able to connect to wifi/bluetooth. We will have extras for students that don't have them or forget to bring them.

Students that are not participating in PSAT testing will be participating in *Tools for Your Future* Virtually.

Please note that Wednesday, October 13th is neither an A or B day, and this week only, Thursday the 14th is an A day and Friday the 15th is a B day.
