The process of distributing graduation tickets is about to begin. As the big event on June 8th at 5:00pm at Providence Park nears, please know that we need to use their Seat Geek ticketing system to distribute ALL tickets electronically. Here is what we need from you. Please send the email you want the tickets delivered to and the number of tickets needed to either Dan Malone or Eva Martinez-Mercado starting this week. Use the phone of an adult who will attend the ceremony. We strongly suggest that you do not use your graduate's phone as they will be in a whole different section of the Park than families when it is time for you to enter the Park (starting at 4:30pm on the 8th). Starting on or about the 25th, we will start to send tickets out through the Seat Geek platform. All seats this year are General Admission and unlike last year, there are no restrictions on how many tickets per row we can use. There is an easy way to transfer tickets to other family members from the original batch of tickets you receive. I will send that email in the letter in early June. For those with young children, Providence Park expects everyone 3 and older to have their own seat.
