Hello Senior Parents,

A reminder to send your graduation ticket request to me at <u>dmalone@pps.net</u>. A few suggestions as you plan to attend the big event.

• We suggest that you have a meeting place planned before everyone departs for the program. With 4000 attendees of our graduation leaving the venue and 4000 attendees lining up to attend the Ida B. Wells ceremony which follows ours, it may be hard to connect.

• We strongly advise that graduates wear comfortable shoes to the event. They will traverse most of Providence Park from the time they line up to the time they meet you after the event, so something that can handle the many, many stairs and a good distance would be a smart choice.

• Students may decorate their caps as long as they are appropriate. Many use the space to advertise what path they are following next or a special thank you.

• Students would be wise to put their names in their caps if they plan to toss them in the air after the tassel turn.

#### UPDATE: BENSON SWIM TEAMS FOR 2022-2023

Parents and Students,

The Athletic Department is committed to bringing back the full complement of OSAA Sanctioned sports to Benson Tech. Girls Golf returned this spring and Football is returning in the Fall of 2024. We made a push to bring back Swimming in 21-22 but did not quite have the minimum numbers in order to qualify. However, it was a good effort in a short amount of time.

Well...we are trying again and with your help we are going to make it for 22-23.

Sports Registration for the 22-23 school year is now open...and it includes swimming. Benson swimming is all set up and ready to go from a resource standpoint.

WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE TO BRING SWIM TEAMS BACK?

If you have a child who wants to be on the swim team for 22-23 we need them to register for the team right now! That's it. This can be done by going to bensonathletics.net and you will see the links to register on the home page. We have received permission to delay the sports fee payment until we know for sure that we are bringing it back. Once we confirm that swim teams are back we will come back to sports fee payments.

As soon as we hit the minimum numbers I will be presenting this to the District so that we can get on the schedule for practices and meets. I will be monitoring the registrations throughout the summer and will do this at any point when we hit the target number.

Bottom line...if you are wanting to be on the swim team next year the time is now to register. Student turnout is the only thing that is stopping our teams from officially being back. Don't wait!

#### An Important Message from Nutrition Services

At the end of the school year, all student account balances (positive and negative), automatically rollover to the following school year. If a PPS student transfers\* or transitions to another PPS school, for example from 5th grade to middle school, or 8th grade to high school, families do not need to contact PPS Nutrition Services to transfer the funds. The funds are linked to the student's 6-digit student ID#, not the school they attend.

If a student(s) has unused funds, families have the following options:

- Do nothing. The funds will remain in the account for the student to purchase a meal at any PPS feeding site.
- Request a refund check. NOTE: Checks are sent in the mail within 4-6 weeks. Depending on the volume of requests, it may take less or more time to process.
- Request the funds be transferred to another PPS student's meal account. Request the funds be donated to a specific school or general fund to pay off negative balances.

\*NOTE to SchoolCafe Users: If the student transfers to an out-of-district school (in Oregon) that also uses SchoolCafe, a new account is not needed. Parents can update the school/district information via the SchoolCafe Profile. However, funds are not transferable. PPS families can request funds with one of the options listed above.
